

RESPONSES TO THE ACTION ITEMS
from the July 28, 2021 JBCC Cleanup Team Meeting

1. Request from Phil Goddard for the regulators/AFCEC decide on one unit of measurement for consistency.

AFCEC and the other agencies will endeavor to use consistent units of measurements. However, it might not always be appropriate (for example in referencing documents that report data with other units of measurements or citing regulations that use alternate units).

2. Request from Phil Goddard: “I understand the outcome of any site is not determined because we are not finalizing the feasibility studies yet, but if it were determined you could cap in place, how you would monitor it – would you use clay or a synthetic cap, or incineration, or if it is a large volume would you intend to put it into a modern landfill and what that means – what kind of landfill (subtitle C, D or whatever)? I would like to hear some options at the next meeting.”

Alternatives for addressing PFAS will be evaluated during the Feasibility Study phase that is upcoming and alternatives that are evaluated and carried forward will be presented to the JBCCCT.
