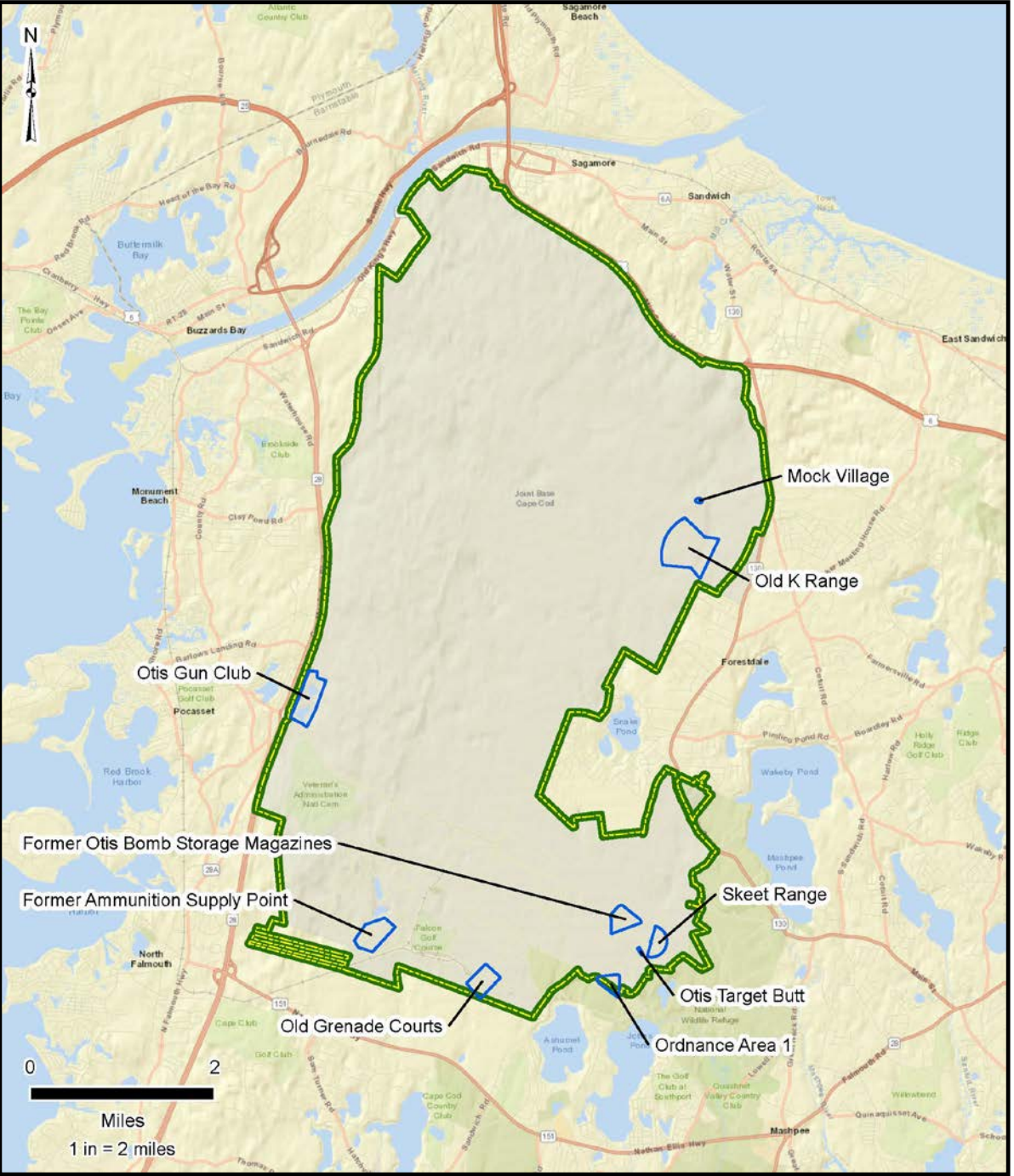

Site Name	Historic Use	Phase	Status
Former Otis Target Butt	Small arms training	Site Closure	No Further Response Action Planned Decision Document (NFRAP DD) – Advertised document for 30-day public review, no comments received. EPA/MassDEP concurrence received; pending AFCEC signature
Former Otis Bomb Storage Magazines	Ordnance storage	Site Closure	NFRAP DD – Advertised document for 30-day public review, no comments received. Awaiting EPA/MassDEP concurrence
Skeet Range	Small arms training	Remedial Investigation (RI)	Lead concentrations higher and in a larger area than originally anticipated; preparing RI Work Plan
Ordnance Area 1	Ordnance storage	Streamlined RI/Feasibility Study (FS)	Draft RI/FS report in preparation. Plan to conduct clearance of off-base portion (~8 acres); need to work with stakeholders. If no ordnance discovered then prepare NFRAP DD and close site.

Site Name	Historic Use	Phase	Status
Otis Gun Club	Small arms training	RI/FS	AFCEC responding to regulatory comments on Draft RI Report
Old Grenade Courts	Training with practice and live grenades	RI/FS	Draft report in preparation. Challenge with portion of site extending off base onto Crane Wildlife property. AFCEC cannot enforce LUCs on non-federal government property. Working with property owners and regulators to determine path forward.
Mock Village	Urban training complex, mock German village	RI/FS	AFCEC responding to regulatory comments on Draft RI/FS Report
Old K Range	Small arms and rocket range training	RI/FS	Finalizing RI. Preparing FS.
Former Ammunition Supply Point (FASP)	Ordnance storage	NFA	EPA rescinded No Further Action (NFA) and requested additional information; AFCEC is responding to request.
