
Why: Enlisted Soldiers desiring to become Warrant

AFCT Background

- The Armed Forces Classification Test (AFCT) is a multi-part test that is used by the military to identify individual aptitudes and areas of greatest career potential.
- The AFCT is a test of ability and an indication of SECRETS academic readiness to pursue a particular career study Guide choice.
- The AFCT is an important tool in the selection
 process for Warrant Officer Candidate School
 (WOCS).

AFCT Sub Tests

- The AFCT is divided into nine sub tests, including:
 - Arithmetic Reasoning (AR)
 - Word Knowledge (WK)
 - Paragraph Comprehension (PC)
 - General Science (GS)
 - Mathematics Knowledge (MK)
 - Electronics Information (EI)
 - Auto & Shop Information (AS)
 - Mechanical Comprehension (MC)
 - Assembling Objects (AO)



GT Portion of the AFCT


- The General Technical (GT) portion of the test is comprised of the following subtests: AR, WK, & PC
 - Arithmetic Reasoning (AR)......16 questions, 39 minutes
 - Arithmetic Reasoning questions will involve the following basic math skills:
 - Basic operations including: Adding/Subtracting/Multiplying/Dividing with Whole Numbers, Fractions, Decimals, Integers, and Algebraic Terms
 - Ratios & Scales
 - Finding Percentages
 - Solving Simple Equations
 - Basic Geometry
 - Mathematics



GT Portion of the AFCT

- The General Technical (GT) portion of the test is comprised of the following subtests: AR, WK, & PC
 - Word Knowledge (WK).....16 questions, 8 minutes
 - Basic vocabulary knowledge including:
 - Vocabulary
 - Meaning in Context (give the definition of a word from context)
 - Synonyms





GT Portion of the AFCT

- The General Technical (GT) portion of the test is comprised of the following subtests: AR, WK, & PC
 - Paragraph Comprehension (PC)..11 questions, 22 minutes
 - Some of the skills the Paragraph Comprehension section will test:
 - Drawing logical conclusions
 - Identify the author's intent
 - Make predictions
 - Analyze and evaluate the use of text structure to solve problems or identify sequences
 - Find information from a graphic (chart or similar, graphic representation)
 - Identify and use scales, legends on a sample map

Resources: Active Duty v. ARNG

- Active Duty Soldiers
 - Basic Skills Education Program (BSEP) classes, part of the Functional Academic Skills Training (FAST) program, provide Soldiers with on-duty instruction in reading and math. The goal is to improve job performance, prepare Soldiers for more advanced schooling, increase reenlistment options and enhance trainability. The majority of Soldiers participate in BSEP classes to increase their General Technical (GT) score.

Resources: Active Duty v. ARNG

- Army National Guard Soldiers
 - Army National Guard Soldiers can enroll in the Active Duty BSEP program, if the circumstances surrounding their situation permits them to do so.
 - Several online resources are available that focus on improving arithmetic reasoning, word knowledge, and paragraph comprehension (the three sub-categories that make up the GT score).



Online Academic Skills Course

- The Peterson's Online Academic Skills Course (OASC) is the primary curriculum used for BSEP classes and can be found at:

- This curriculum standardizes the BSEP program
 Army-wide. It also offers a self-study online program
 for Soldiers who are unable to attend a classroom
 environment. Peterson's OASC is open to all Service
 Members (Reserve Components included), DoD
 Civilians, and adult family members.

Online Academic Skills Course

- The Peterson's OASC program supports the following mode of instruction:
 - Self-Study: Ending date will be no more than one year from the start date
- The majority of Soldiers participate in BSEP classes to increase their General Technical (GT) score. If a Soldier has successfully enrolled and completed the OASC, the AFCT should be scheduled as soon as possible.




OASC Enrollment Instructions






- 3. Go to "New User", click here;

6. On the left side, click on OASC and take both preassessments, complete all lessons and quizzes, then take post-assessments.






OASC Completion

 Once you have successfully completed the Peterson's OASC, the AFCT should be scheduled as soon as possible.








